

# Stubbins Flexibility Exercise

Listen for smooth, seamless connections between the notes in each register. It is not necessary to do this exercise with a metronome. Therefore, try to play each staff in one breath, assigning approximately equal time values to each pitch. (Accidentals hold through the entire staff)
