## Styles:

Pop:

- Keep chords simple overall. A few ninths, but not many.
- Right hand plays chords near middle C
- Left hand plays roots and fifths
- Lots of sustained chords remember the drummer and the guitarist are providing most of the rhythm. If you play very much stuff, you will most likely just make things muddy.

Jazz Swing and Latin:

- Use substitute chords to whatever extent you are able.
- Left hand plays chord near middle C
- Right hand plays tune, improvised solo, or roots and fifths (usually octaves)
- When using both hands to comp, play the exact same rhythm in both hands.
- Use short, syncopated rhythms. The "Charleston" rhythm is an excellent place to start.
